

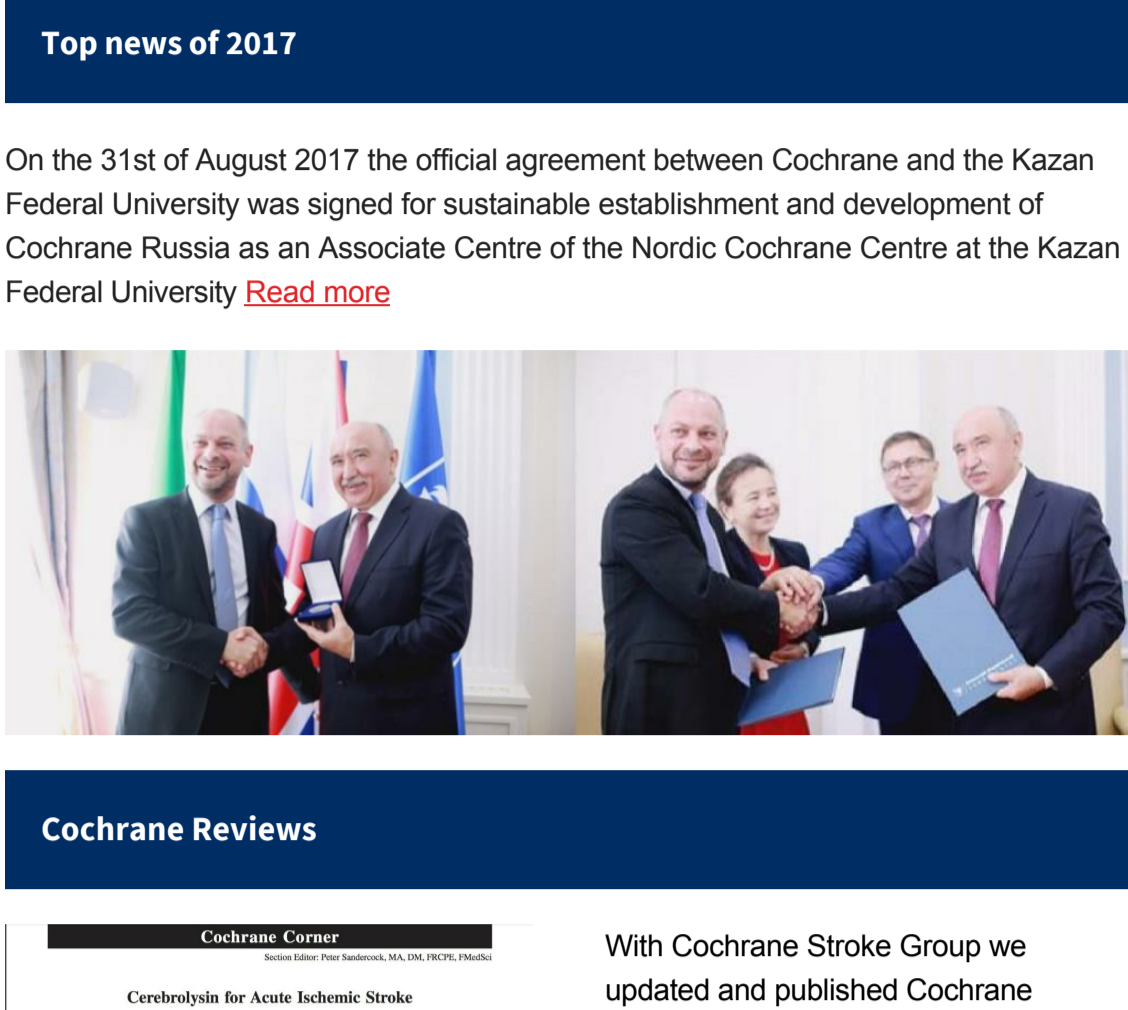

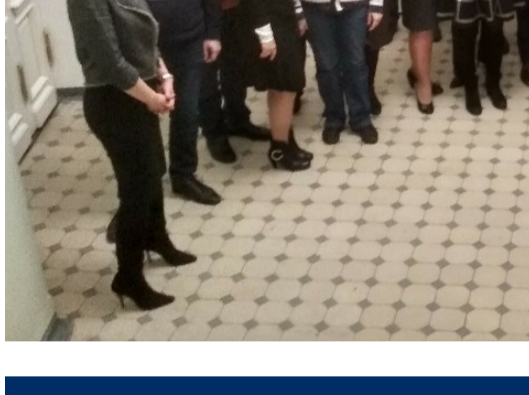

With Cochrane Epilepsy Group we published the protocol for Cochrane systematic review "[Gabapentin monotherapy for epilepsy](#)"

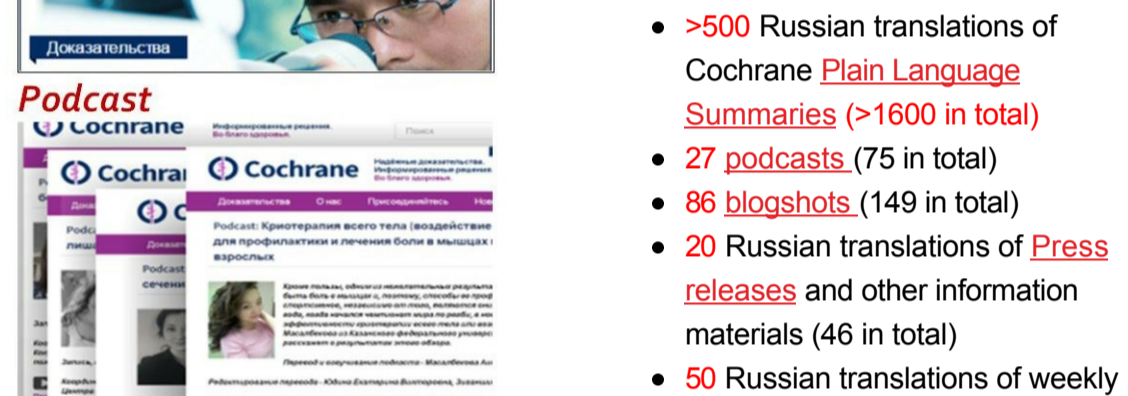

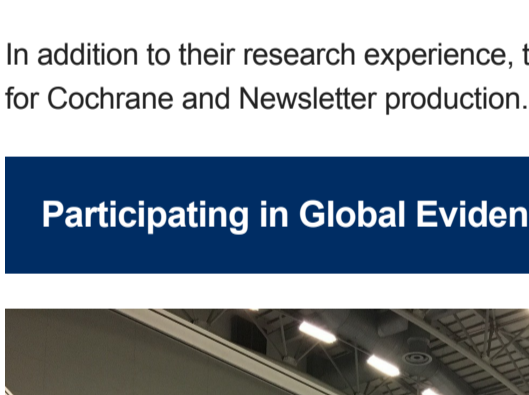

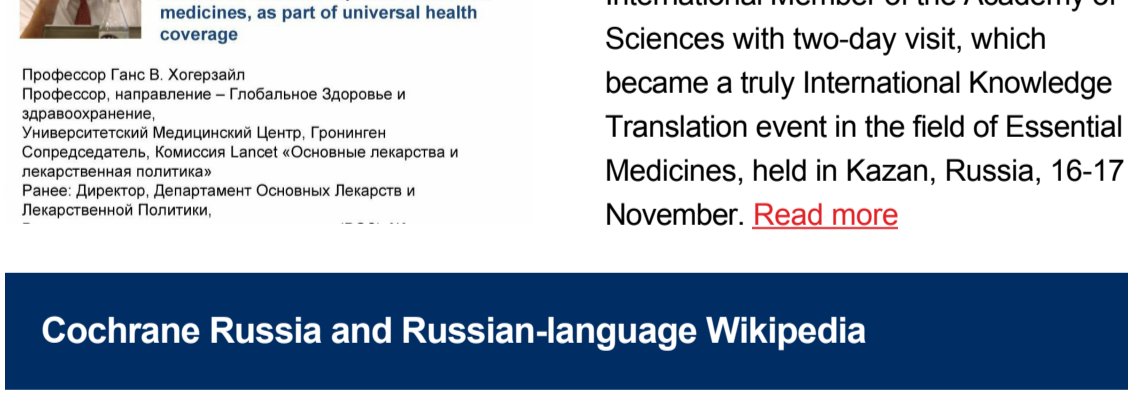
In addition to their research experience, they contributed to Russian Translation project for Cochrane and Newsletter production.

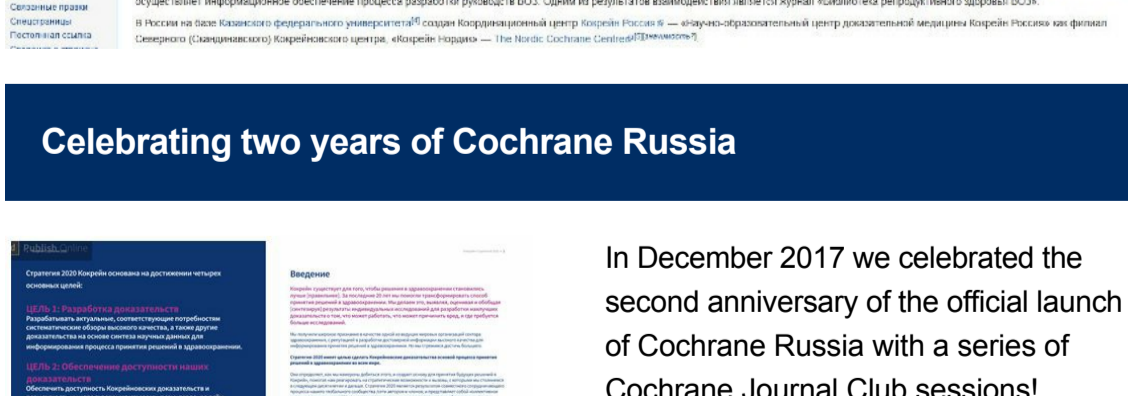

Celebrating two years of Cochrane Russia

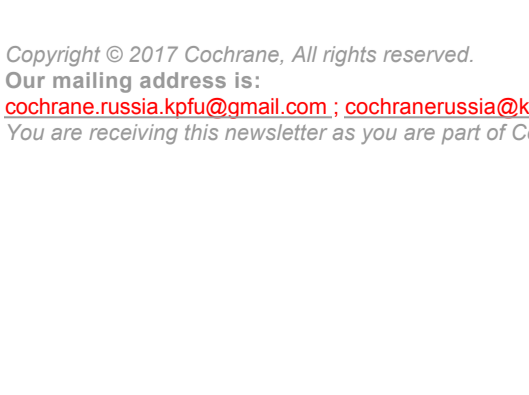
